Through a partnership with Lumina Foundation and Rockefeller Philanthropy Advisors, the Center received \$1 million to support the National Assessment of Collegiate Campus Climates (NACCC) and the USC Equity Institutes.


The NACCC, a quantitative survey, will be administered annually at hundreds of colleges and universities. It will provide data about students' encounters with racism and racial stress on campus, the extent to which they interact meaningfully with diverse others, where and what they learn about race, their feelings of readiness for citizenship in a racially diverse democracy after college, and other relevant topics.

The grant also supports a professional learning series that will engage 200 leaders on to campuses over eight weeks. Each USC Equity institute is comprised of eight po-imitute virtual modules on topics like leading in moments of racial crisis, recruiting and retaining a racially diverse faculty, and strategic planning for racial equity, to name a few. Center staff and institute faculty will also coach and provide engoing support to the 20 participants on each campus as they design four sustainable racial equity projects that launch at the conclusion of the eight-week online module series.

"The image of angry, torch-bearing white nationalists and the many other incidents seen over the course of the last year on college campuses has been a stark reminder of the subborn tenacity of racis in our nation," Lumina President Lamie Merisotis worte in a statement announcing the Foundations in westment of a 25 million to confront racism and correct racial inequities in higher education.
